- In Acts 2, the early days of the church notices the activity of their community gatherings.
- In Acts 20, 30+ years after the Resurrection, Paul is still teaching in his home and the church is meeting house to house
- In Rev 2,3: 60 years after the Resurrection Jesus is walking among the churches, who are meeting within homes through the cities being addressed.

Three Core Values - Leaders go first in modeling in all these areas

Authenticity ** The Mask Board

- to be Sincere, Genuine (not fake)
- no hiding and no guarded
- Counterfitness is easy to recognize

<u>Curiosity</u> (for more see Roy's notes)

- We all want to be loved and known, but we fear being known because, "If you knew me you wouldn't love me."
- Curiosity is more than asking good questions of others. It is asking good questions of yourself and of the Word.
- Good leaders ask great questions of themselves, others and of God.

Accountability

- Is not about Control, it's about CARE. Care fosters safety.
- It is not Contractual but Covenant. It is the "one another's" at work. Covenant is about being "knit together" through mutual protection and vision.
- It is TWO way caring
- It is fueled by having shared vision for your life and others.

What is the desired Impact of Small Groups?

<u>Life Transformation</u> - freedom, addictions broken, salvations, healings, marriages saved

<u>Relationships</u> - connections to help you through life and growth <u>Mission</u> - a go for it mission.

The mission will call the shots for your group. IE Multiplication is a must for the mission

What do we do in the Small Group Gatherings?

Our aim is to have a conversation in a safe place that helps people see life through the lens of who they are in Christ as revealed in the Word.
